**Proclaim**


- **Every morning:**
  - **Pray for an open door to share the gospel with someone from your list.**
  - **Pray for boldness** (In Ephesians 6:19 Paul said, “[pray] also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel”)
